The CUET (Central Universities Entrance Test) is a nationwide entrance examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission into various undergraduate programs offered by participating central universities, state universities, deemed universities, and private universities across India. This centralizes the entrance process for students seeking admission to a wide range of undergraduate programs.

Eligibility criteria for CUET?

Choosing the right under graduation program after 12th standard can be overwhelming with various universities offering specialized options. This table summarizes the eligibility criteria for different under graduation programs based on the associated central government, state government and private universities:

CUET Cut-off & Exam Pattern

There is **no fixed or sectional cut-offs** exist for the CUET exam. The reasons are:

1. Admissions are administered by individual universities, however, CUET is a centralized entrance exam.
 2. Based on applicant numbers, exam difficulty, and seat availability, each participating university sets its own course cut-offs.
 3. Cut-offs vary by university, course popularity, and application category (General, OBC, SC/ST, etc.).
- How to estimate cut-offs:
 - University Websites: Visit your desired universities' official websites. For reference, they may disclose last year's cut-offs.
 - Expected Scores: Find news articles or educational portals that study past trends and predict 2019 cut-offs. These are estimates, not facts.
 - Get Good Scores: Cut-offs matter, but exam performance matters more. High scores boost your chances of getting into your selected program.

CUET exam pattern is mentioned below:

Mode of Exam	Online Computer Based Test (CBT)
Question Type	Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) only
Sections	There are three main sections, with an optional fourth: 1. Languages, 2. Domain-Specific Subjects, 3. General Test (Optional)
Marking Scheme	+4 marks for each correct answer, 0 marks for incorrect or unattempted questions (No Negative Marking)

Section IA

English, Hindi, Gujarati, Bengali, Assamese, Kannada, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Marathi, Punjabi, Odia, and Urdu.

Section IB

Chinese, German, French, Arabic, Italian, Japanese, Nepali, Russian, Spanish, Tibetan, Dogri, Bodo, Kashmiri, Konkani, Maithili, Manipuri, Santhali, and Sindhi.

The CUET syllabus consists of three broad sections:

Sections	Description	Details
Section IA & IB	Language	RC (Reading Comprehension), Grammar, Books & Authors, etc.
Section II	Domain Subjects	Complete NCERT Class 12 syllabus
Section III	General Test (GT)	General awareness, Numerical abilities, Logical Reasoning, etc.

Stage	Description
Registration	Online registration, choose universities/programs
Take the Exam	Computer-based test with multiple-choice questions (Language, Domain Subjects, General Knowledge)
Receive Results	Overall & section-wise scores declared online
Research University Admissions	Specific procedures & weightage of CUET scores
Shortlisting	Based on CUET score & university criteria
