The NPAT (National Test for Programs After Twelfth) is an entrance examination conducted by the Narsee Monjee Institute of Management Studies (NMIMS) for admission into various undergraduate programs offered by the institute. NMIMS is a wellknown private university in India, offering programs in fields like management, engineering, commerce, economics, liberal arts, science, and design.

The NPAT syllabus consists of three broad sections:

Quantitative Reasoning (40 Questions): This section tests your ability to solve problems using mathematical concepts. The topics covered in this section include arithmetic, algebra, geometry, trigonometry, and statistics.

Verbal Reasoning (40 Questions): This section tests your ability to understand and analyze written text. The topics covered in this section include reading comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, and critical reasoning.

Logical Reasoning (40 Questions): This section tests your ability to identify patterns, analyze information, and draw logical conclusions. The topics covered in this section include critical thinking, data analysis, syllogisms, and puzzles.















Selection Process

So, what is the selection process of the courses?

Apply & Register: Submit your application for NPAT and choose your preferred NMIMS colleges for the BBA program.

Take the NPAT Test: Ace the computer-based NPAT exam with sections on math, reading comprehension, and logical reasoning. **Results & Merit List**: NMIMS announces the NPAT scores and prepares a merit list based on your score.

College Allotment: Based on your merit rank and college preferences, NMIMS assigns you a seat at an NMIMS college offering BBA.

Counselling (Optional): You might be invited to a counselling session to confirm your acceptance of the offered seat and finalize your admission.

Stage	Description
Application and NPAT Exam	Register online, submit documents, choose programs/campuses, pay fees, take computerbased NPAT test.
Shortlisting Based on Cutoffs	NMIMS evaluates exam performance, releases cutoffs (overall & possibly sectional). Only those above the cutoffs proceed.
Selection of Campuses and Programs	Shortlisted candidates choose preferred campuses and programs during a designated window. Choices may be prioritized based on NPAT score and seat availability.
Interview	Applicable for some programs only. Shortlisted candidates attend interviews to assess soft skills, communication, and program motivation.
Final Merit List and Offer of Admission	NMIMS prepares a final merit list per program/campus based on NPAT score (and interview score if applicable). Top ranked candidates receive admission offers.
