- D put on at the meeting

**Q3.**

In a farmhouse , there are only horses and sheep. If 50% of the horses were sheep, then there would have been 50% more sheep than the number of horses. What percentage of all the animals are horses? **(QA -2024)**

- A 80%
- B 50%
- C 40%
- D 60%

Let horses = H, sheep = S.

If 50% of horses were sheep:

- Horses = 0.5 H, sheep = S+0.5H

Given:

$$S+0.5H=1.5\times 0.5H=0.75H\Rightarrow S=0.25H$$

$$\text{Total animals} = H+S=H+0.25H=1.25H$$

Percentage of horses =

$$H/1.25H\times 100=80\%$$

Answer: A) 80%





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### Sample Questions

**Q4.**

The population of the town increased from 1,50,000 to 2,24,500 in 11 years. The average percentage increase of population per year is:

- A 4.54%
- B 8.75%
- C 4.52%
- D 4.37%

**(QA - 2024)**

A4.

Initial = 150,000, Final = 224,500, Time = 11 years.

Final = Initial \* (1+ increase %)<sup>11</sup>

Increase % =  $(224500/150000)^{(1/11)} - 1 = 4.52\%$

**Q5.**

The cost price of 25 articles is the same as the selling price of 'm' articles. If the profit is 25%, then what is the value of 'm'? **(QA - 2024)**

- A 20
- B 25
- C 18
- D 16

Let CP of 25 articles be Rs.25

Profit = 25%

Therefore, SP =  $25/1.25 = 20$

Number of articles =  $20/1 = 20$

**Q6.**

Two friends, Rama and Jaya, appeared an examination. Rama secured 8 marks more than Jaya and her marks was 55% of the sum of their marks. The marks obtained by them are: **(QA 2024)**

- A 41, 49
- B 36, 44
- C 32, 40
- D 38, 46

Rama got 8 more marks than Jaya =  $J+8$

Rama's marks = 55% (J+R) = 55% (J+J+8)

$J+8 = 55\% (J+J+8)$

$3.6 = 0.1 J$

$J = 36$

Rama's marks =  $J+8 = 36+8 = 44$

Therefore the answer is B (36,44)
